## 4. Corrective Actions

- a. Corrective actions are taken on an ongoing basis.

## 5. Efforts Toward Progress

- a. The PREA coordinator attends quarterly meetings with Sexual Assault Interagency Council to network with other professionals working together to address sexual abuse.

## 6. Findings

- a. This agency continues to address sexual abuse by updating the policies, procedures and training as needed to combat this issue and help promote a safe environment for all.
